

URMCA 2026/2027 Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

The Utah Ready Mixed Concrete Association has established a scholarship program to foster the development of Concrete production, management, construction and design professionals.

SCHOLARSHIPS GUIDELINES

The Utah Ready Mixed Concrete Association will award up to ten separate one-time scholarships to up to ten individuals, each in the amount of \$2,500. The award will be based on the combination of scholastic achievement, financial need and contributions to the fields of Concrete or Construction Management, Structural or Civil Engineering or Architecture.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Scholarship recipients must reside within the URMCA boundaries (the state of Utah). Preference will be given to US Citizens.
- B. Applicants must be students in good standing enrolled as a Junior, Senior, or Graduate Student in an Utah accredited university/college during the scholarship period.
- C. Applicants must be pursuing a degree in Concrete or Construction Management, Structural or Civil Engineering, or Architecture.
- D. Applicants should demonstrate a career goal in becoming employed within the concrete construction industry.
- E. Preference will be given to applicants who have shown an interest in the concrete construction industry through their education and or work experience. Students having full-time, part-time or co-op “hands-on” work experience in the concrete industry are especially encouraged to apply. Applicants should have engaged in project activity or employment related to the production, fabrication, estimating, detailing, supervision or inspection of concrete or in the gainful pursuit of experience directly involved in concrete construction.
- F. Applicants should not be related to any member of the URMCA Board of Directors or Executive Director.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Complete the Scholarship Application and submit with the items listed below:

- I. A cover letter/personal statement of approximately 250 words describing the applicant's career interests, personal objectives, and statement expressing interest in concrete and other information that would give insight into the applicant's aptitude.
- ii. Official transcripts from all post-secondary colleges and universities attended. The transcript from the current school must be the most recent.
- iii. Two Letters of Recommendation, one academic reference, and one work reference, submitted by email directly from the writer.
- Iv. Student's FAFSA form if indicating a financial need.

SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS

Selections will be based on student's overall academic progress and success, financial need, and the conveyance of how this financial aid will help the applicant earn a degree and make a difference in the fields of Concrete or Construction Management, Structural or Civil Engineering, or Architecture. The Utah Ready Mixed Concrete Association does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, age, gender, national origin, religion, or disability.

NOTICE OF AWARDS

Students will be notified of any scholarship award or denial. Payment of any award will be made directly to the school/university of the enrolled student.
